Greetings All:

The Daytona International Antique Tackle Show will be held on February 27th, 28th, and until noon on March 1st, 2023. This falls on a Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, which we have chosen for several reasons.

First, weekday room rates are much more affordable. Also, with fewer guests, parking issues will be minimized. Lastly, the hotel will give the club a much better price on the ballrooms. As many of you know, hotel rates have gone up tremendously over the past year. People are anxious to travel again and hotels are attempting to make up for lost revenue due to the pandemic.

This year's table prices will start at \$35.00 each, good until July 1, 2022. For funds received after July 1^{st,} until December 31st, table cost will go to \$40.00 each. Any table purchases received after January 1, 2023 will be \$50.00 each. No tables will be reserved until they are paid in full, and there will be no refunds after January 1st. These increases are essential in keeping with current and future price hikes on tables, labor and hotel costs.

We will have an early registration on Sunday, February 26th, from 3pm until 5pm.

For hotel reservations, our group starting rate is \$129 per night. Ocean view and ocean front rooms will run higher. Please get your reservations in early as our block rates will expire on January 1, 2023. The Plaza Resort and Spa can be reached at 1-855-262-1990.
